**City of Harahan - New Sales Tax Levy**

Please note the governing authority of the City of Harahan, State of Louisiana by passage of Ordinance No. 1936 has imposed a levy of eight-tenths percent (0.8%) sales tax to be levied and collected beginning July 1, 2022. This sales tax is imposed upon the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental, the consumption, and the storage for use or consumption, of tangible personal property in, and on the sale of services performed within, the corporate limits of the City of Harahan. This levy is in addition to all other sales taxes and is subject to the Uniform Local Sales Tax Code. There are no optional exemptions or exclusions from this tax and it applies to the sale of food and prescription drugs.

The sales tax levied above shall be collected in the same manner, under the same terms and conditions and with the same delinquent penalty (5% percent per month, not to exceed 25%), interest (1% per month on the unpaid balance until paid), and vendor's compensation (1% of the amount due if payment is not delinquent at the time of payment) as all other sales taxes collected by the Bureau of Revenue and Taxation of the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office.

The adoption of this levy will require all taxpayer/dealers to accurately identify, and report separately, the sales of goods and merchandise made in and services performed within the corporate limits of the City of Harahan from all other sales of goods and merchandise made in and services performed within all other areas of Jefferson Parish beginning July 1, 2022.

It is important to note that this additional sales tax is only applicable in the corporate limits of the City of Harahan. All locations within the City of Harahan have a zip code of 70123; however, this new levy does not apply in areas of unincorporated Jefferson Parish sharing the zip code 70123 and often referred to as Elmwood, River Ridge or New Orleans. To assist in identifying municipal addresses inside the corporate limits of the City of Harahan, as well as all other areas of Louisiana, the Louisiana Uniform Local Sales Tax Board has developed a Sales Tax Lookup Tool. The Lookup Tool is designed to provide domicile information including applicable state and local sales tax rates, optional exemptions, etc. for a particular municipal address or coordinates by Geocode and can be accessed by a single address lookup, bulk lookup or API link. Updated sales tax forms have been generated to reflect this new sales tax levy, in both paper and electronic formats, for the proper reporting and remittance of sales and use taxes in Jefferson Parish. Online filers must update their form selection with Parish e-file or SalesTaxOnline accordingly to properly file and remit Jefferson Parish sales taxes for periods beginning July 2022.
